RSIPF investigates car break-in in West Guadalcanal

Officers of the Royal Solomon Islands Police Force (RSIPF) in Guadalcanal Province are investigating an incident of car break-in at the Bonege beach, West Guadalcanal on 14 April 2019.

It is alleged that on 14 April 2019 at around 0900hrs the victim went diving at Bonege beach. He locked his car and went diving.

During that time, someone damaged his car screen and gained entry into the car and removed three black bags, one laptop and a drone.

The incident was reported to police and officers attended the scene.

Provincial Police Commander Guadalcanal Province, Chief Superintendent Evelyn Thugea says, "Investigations into this matter is currently underway. I would like to call on community members and those living around the area to come forward with information relating to the incident."
