### **Mangau emphasises importance of ABP during the official opening of the PPCs and DDs of RSIPF Conference in Honiara**

The Commissioner of the Royal Solomon Islands Police Force (RSIPF), Mr. Mostyn Mangau, in his presentation after the official opening of the Provincial Police Commander (PPCs) and Departmental Directors (DDs) of the RSIPF, emphasized the importance of the Annual Business Plan (ABP).

The PPCs and DDs Conference official opening occurred on 27 October 2025, at the Rove Police Headquarters in Honiara.

Commissioner Mangau, in his presentation, emphasized the importance of having a proper work plan in guiding police leaders and officers in their daily duties in their respective workplaces and communities they looked after.

Mr. Mangau said, "To be good leaders for the people we serve, we must have a work plan to guide us. This is the only way we can achieve what we want to do and what is best for the people we serve and become the best police organization in the region."
