Community visits were also carried out at Tamone, Burns Creek, and the Motor Pool communities. During these visits, the RAPPP teams shared Christmas gifts with children, spent time listening to community members, and strengthened relationships through simple but meaningful interactions.

The Christmas outreach reflects RAPPP's continued commitment to community policing, partnership, and supporting vulnerable members of the community through presence, compassion, and connection, especially during a time of year that holds deep meaning for families and children.
