CMT conducted free health care check for RSIPF

The China Medical Team (CMT) has conducted a free medical check for the officers of the Royal Solomon Island Police Force (RSIPF) at Rove police headquarters on 28 August 2026.

Medical professionals of CMT check a good number of RSIPF officers for blood pressure, blood sugar level, chronic diseases, and frequently occurring diseases, and provide free medicines.

CMT has been providing crucial, free healthcare services across the Solomon Islands since 2022 with their outreach programme to all the provinces.

They are working with local staff at the National Referral Hospital (NRH) in Honiara and conducting extensive outreach programmes.

Acting RSIPF Commissioner Mr James Aitorea thanked the China Police Liaison Team (CPLT) for the arrangement to conduct free medical care services for our officers and their families.
