- Receive the rape survivor
- Immediately start psychological support
- Assess urgent medical needs
- Take history

Within 72 hours after the incident

- Physical examination
- Care of physical injuries
- Pregnancy test/checklist for pre-existing pregnancy
- Provide Emergency Contraception
- Prescribe STI treatment
- Risk assessment for HIV
- Offer VCT / Provide PEP for HIV
- Vaccinate (Hep B & Tetanus)

From 72 hours to 120 hours after the incident

- Physical examination
- Pregnancy test/checklist for pre-existing pregnancy
- Provide Emergency Contraception
- Prescribe STI treatment
- Offer VCT
- Vaccinate (Hep B & Tetanus)

More than 120 hours after the incident

- Physical examination
- Ascertain if pregnant by rape
- Counsel accordingly
- Prescribe STI treatment
- Offer VCT
- Vaccinate (Hep B & Tetanus)

• Provide psycho-social care, offer medical certificate, and make a follow-up plan
